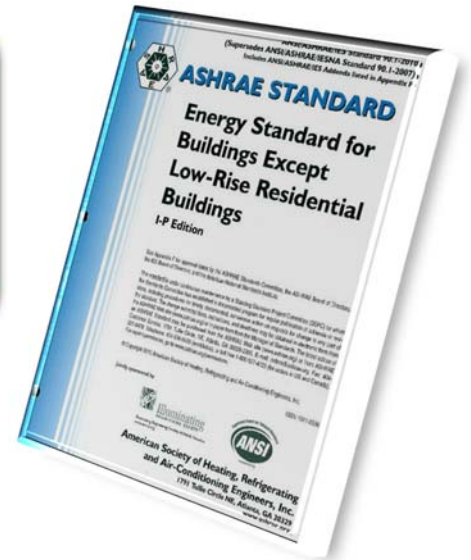


ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2010 Update & Overview Full-Day Training

Effective September 1, 2011 all state-funded commercial buildings are required to be in compliance with the latest edition of ASHRAE 90.1-2010.



The Texas State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) is hosting and funding seven training workshops on the latest energy codes mandated for state-funded buildings, free of charge for participants.

Workshop Focus

The workshop includes a presentation of the current Standard 90.1 document as well as a review of some of the more substantive changes/additions made since the 2007 version, plus an overview of the 189.1 Standard for Green Buildings. The workshop covers:

- The Mandatory and Prescriptive Requirements.
- The ECB methodology and the new Appendix G (Performance Rating Method.)
- The IRS energy tax credits, the AEDG, and the U.S.DOE approved software tool for obtaining federal tax credits.

Who Should Attend

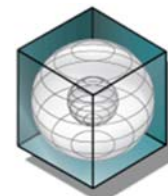
